

1.1 Total Migration to the City of Boroondara 1999/00 and 2000/01¹

A total of 818 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Boroondara on entering Australia in 2000/01. This compares to 663 people in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of people came from China representing 16% of the total.

1.2 Family Migration to the City of Boroondara 2000/01



A total of 259 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Boroondara on entering Australia through Family Migration in 2000/01. In 2000/01 the largest number of people were born in China, representing 19% of all entrants..


1.3 Humanitarian Entrants to the City of Boroondara 1999/00 and 2000/01

A total of 46 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Boroondara on entering Australia through the Humanitarian program in 2000/01. This compares to 26 people in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of entrants (24%) were born in China.

1.4 Skilled Migration to the City of Boroondara 1999/00 and 2000/01

A total of 513 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Boroondara on entering Australia through the Skilled Migration Program in 2000/01. This compares to 275 people in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of people were born in Malaysia, representing 20% of all skilled migrants. Countries of birth in the category "other" include people from USA, Poland and Pakistan.
