

## 1.1 Total Migration to the City of Manningham 1999/00 and 2000/01<sup>1</sup>

A total of 551 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Manningham on entering Australia in 2000/01. This compares to 495 people in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of people came from China representing 17% of the total.

## 1.2 Family Migration to the City of Manningham 2000/01



A total of 203 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Manningham on entering Australia through Family migration in 2000/01. In 2000/01 the largest number of people were born in China, representing 25% of all entrants.


## 1.3 Humanitarian Entrants to the City of Manningham 1999/00 and 2000/01

A total of 22 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Manningham on entering Australia through the Humanitarian program in 2000/01. This compares to 23 people in the year ending June 2000. The largest number of entrants (36%) were born in China and Iran respectively.

## 1.4 Skilled Migration to the City of Manningham 1999/00 and 2000/01

A total of 326 people indicated that they would settle in the City of Manningham on entering Australia through the Skilled Migration Program in 2000/01. This compares to 208 people in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of people were born in Malaysia, representing 20% of all skilled migrants.
