

## 1.1 Total Migration to the Shire of Yarra Ranges 1999/00 and 2000/01<sup>1</sup>

A total of 131 people indicated that they would settle in the Shire of Yarra Ranges on entering Australia in 2000/01. This compares to 130 in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of people came from the United Kingdom representing 17% respectively of the total.


A total of 84 indicated that they would settle in the Shire of Yarra Ranges on entering Australia through Family Migration in 2000/01. In 2000/01 the largest number of people were born in England, representing 20% of all entrants.

## 1.3 Humanitarian Entrants to the Shire of Yarra Ranges 1999/00 and 2000/01

A total of 4 people indicated that they would settle in the Shire of Yarra Ranges on entering Australia through the Humanitarian program in 2000/01. The countries of birth of entrants were Iran, Burma and not stated. As less than 4 people entered from each country the figures were not provided.

## 1.4 Skilled migration to the Shire of Yarra Ranges 1999/00 and 2000/01

A total of 43 people indicated that they would settle in the Shire of Yarra Ranges on entering Australia through the Skilled Migration Program in 2000/01. This compares to 28 people in the year ending June 2000. In 2000/01 the largest number of people were born in India in, representing 22% of all skilled migrants.
