

proficiency as not well or not at all. Within some communities the percentage was significantly higher with 67% of the Albanian community (6 people), 49% of the Khmer (253 people) and 42% of the Korean region 7% of people live by them selves. In the German speaking community 12% of people live alone and in the Polish and Italian communities the figures are 8% and 3% respectively.
