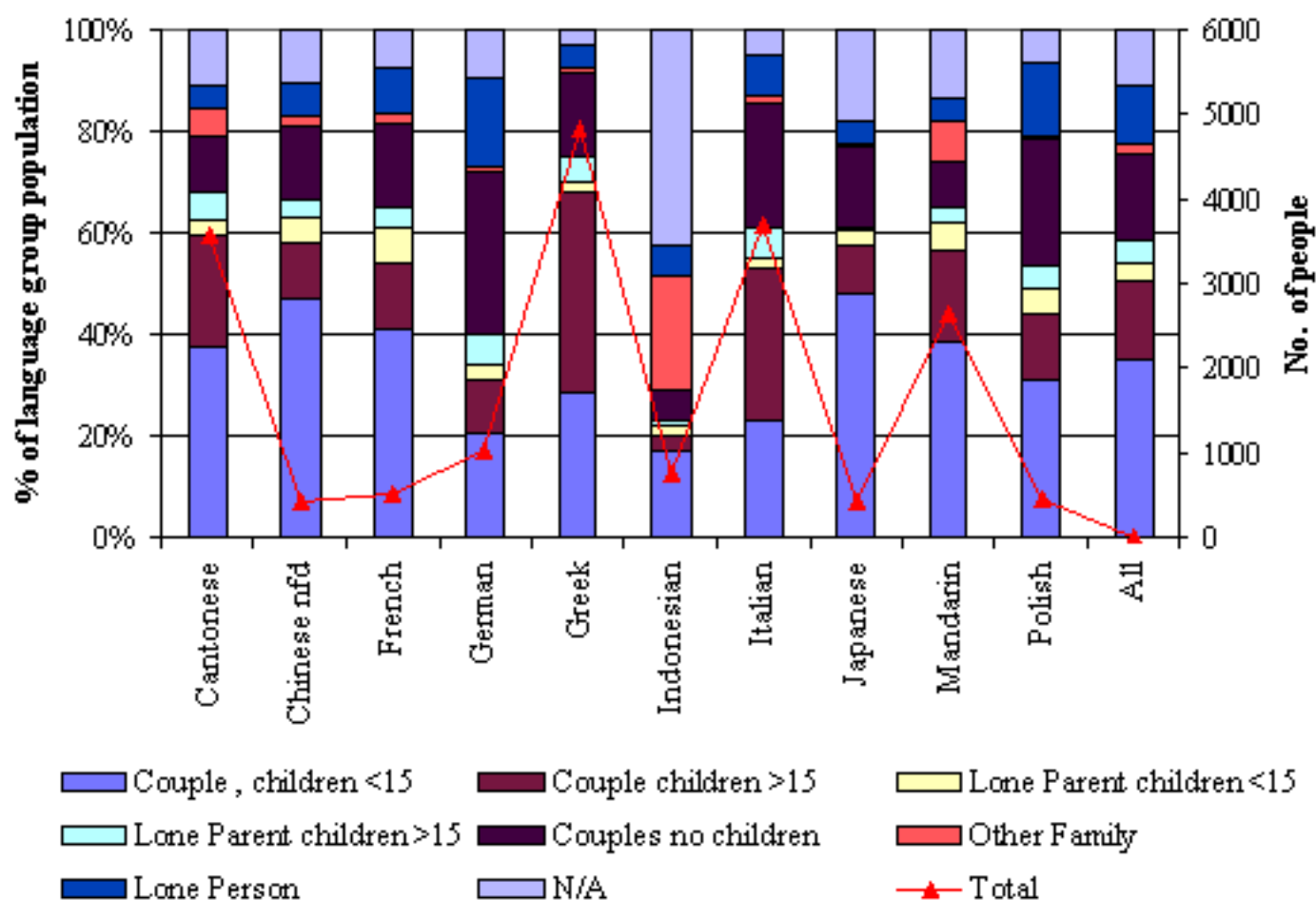

Within the LGA 35% of people live in a household of a couple with children under 15 years of age. Within the Japanese, Chinese nfd, French, Mandarin and Cantonese speaking communities this percentage is higher the figures being 48%, 47%, 41%, 39% and 37% respectively. Not applicable refers to unrelated family members sharing a house, for the LGA as a whole 10% of individuals fit in this category. For other language groups the percentage is much higher, in particularly people speaking Indonesian where 42% of individuals live in shared housing with people who are not related.
