## Languages spoken by residents in the City of Knox<sup>1</sup>.

- There is a total population of 143287 people living in the City of Knox. 81% (115461) of the population speak English at home whilst 16% (22888) do not speak English at home.<sup>2</sup>
- Fifty four different languages are spoken by residents living in Knox.
- The largest Non English Speaking Background (NESB) population speak Cantonese at home, followed by Italian, Greek, German and Mandarin.
- Within the largest 30 NESB communities the oldest population in the Knox is the Dutch speaking population with 55% (340) of the community 60 years of age or more. Other communities with a fifth or more of their population aged 60 years plus are the German speaking community with 52% (770), Hungarian 41% (229) and Italian 22% (516). Across the English speaking population 12% (13574) are aged 60 years plus whilst across NESB communities 16% (3664) of the population is aged 60 years plus. The largest NESB population aged 60 years or over is the German speaking community (770) followed by the Italian community (516).
- Within the largest 30 NESB communities the youngest population in the Knox is the Vietnamese speaking community with 73% (561) of its population under 40 years of age. Other communities with two thirds or more of their population under 40 years of age are, Khmer 70% (243) and Persian 67% (206). Across the English speaking population 61% (69991) are aged 40years or less whilst across NESB communities 52% (11916) of the population is aged 40 years less. The largest NESB population aged 40 years or less is the Cantonese speaking community (1744) followed by the Greek community (1215) and Italian speaking community (1125).

# Country of Birth of residents in the City of Knox<sup>3</sup>

- People from over 130 countries have settled in the Knox.
- The largest number of people born outside of Australia or England were born in Malaysia 1804, followed by New Zealand 1684, Sri Lanka 1524, Germany 1451, India 1395 and Italy 1375.
- 29% (41426) of the total population were born outside of Australia and 24% (33699) of the total population was born outside of Australia and England.
- Within the largest 30 communities the oldest community is the Hungarian born community with 61% (238) of the population over 60 years of age. Other communities with more than 40% of its population aged 60 years or more are: German 49% (708), Netherlandic 47% (595) and Austria 44% (115). 9% (8985) of the Australian born population is aged 60 years or more. The largest number of people aged 60 years or over were born in England (2267), Netherlands (595) and Italy (525).
- Within the largest 30 communities the youngest community is the New Zealand born community where 56% (950) of the population is aged under 40 years. Other communities with more than 50% of their population aged less than 40 years of age are Cambodian 55% (285), Vietnamese 53% (519) and Hong Kong 52% (398). 68% (69162) of the Australian born population is aged less than 40 years. The largest number of people aged 40 years or less were born in England (1957), New Zealand (950), Malaysia (777) and India (639).
