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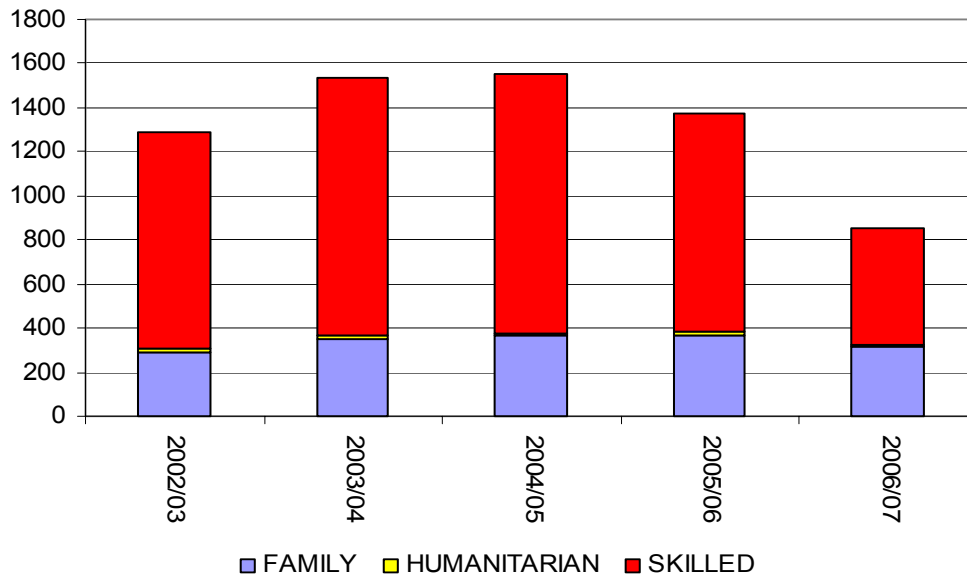
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Settlement in the City of Boroondara by Migration Stream July 1 2002 to June 30 2007¹



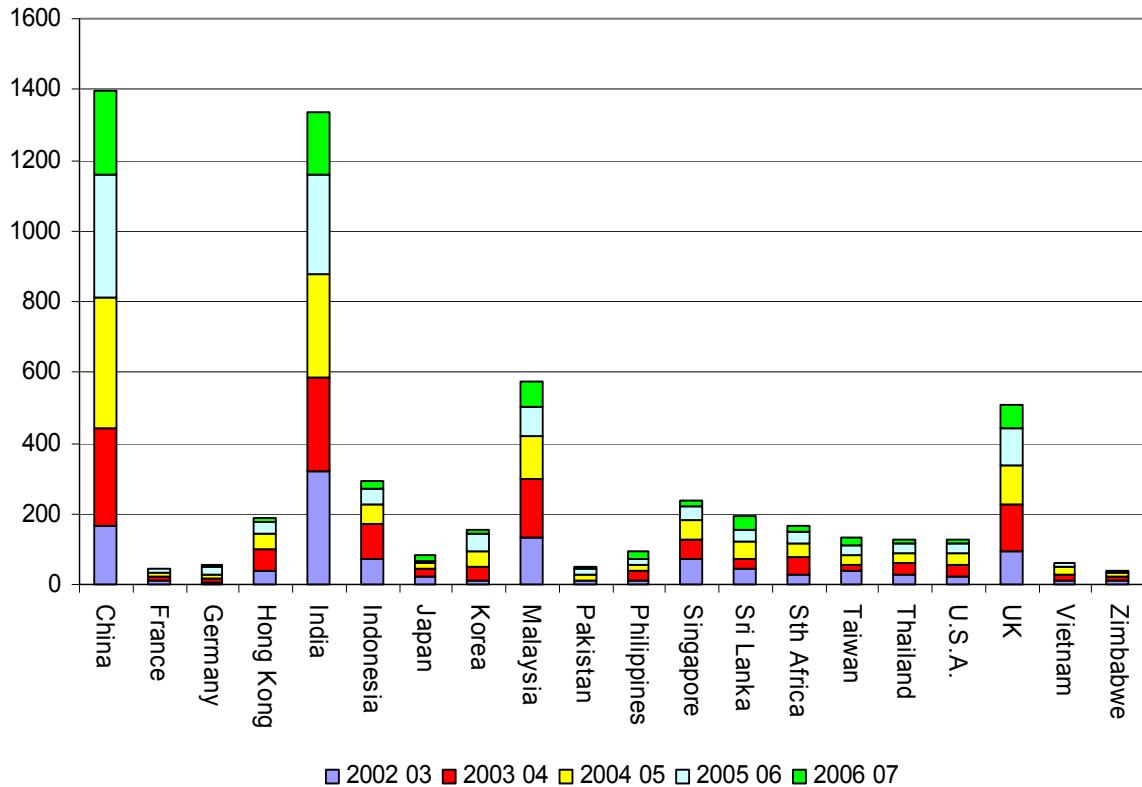
Over 6600 people have settled in the City of Boroondara in the period July 1 2002 to June 30 2007 which represented 18% of all people settling in the Eastern Region. The largest number of people, 24% (1552), entered in 2004/2005.

Twenty percent (4847) of all skilled migrants and 17% (1686) of all family migrants settling in the Eastern Region in the five years ending June 30 2007 settled in the City of Boroondara.

The largest number 73% (4847) of all entrants in the City settled under the Skilled Migration program, followed by 26% (1686) under the Family Migration Program and 1% (69) under the Humanitarian program.

People from 112 countries settled in Boroondara in the five years ending June 30 2007. The largest community settling in the City of Boroondara were born in China (1396), representing 21% of all new settlers. The second largest community settling in Boroondara were born in India (1334). The Indian born population represented 21% of all new settlement in the city.

Eighteen percent of all people who were born in China and who settled in the Eastern Region settled in Boroondara. Similarly 28% of the Indian born community who settled in the region settled in Boroondara.

Languages spoken by residents in the City of Boroondara³

- There is a total population of 154448 people living in the City of Boroondara. Seventy one percent (115810) of these speak English at home whilst 20% (31281) speak a language other than English at home.⁴ The number of people who do not speak at English at home has risen by 15% (4185) since the ABS Census of 2001.
- One hundred and twenty languages are spoken at home by people residing in Boroondara.
- The largest number of people speaking a language other than English speak Mandarin (5257) - this is a 50% (1745) increase in the number of Mandarin speakers from the ABS Census of 2001. The number of people speaking the second largest language group (other than English), Greek, has increased 3% (145) to 4962. The third largest language group other than English is Cantonese where the number of people speaking Cantonese at home has increased by 14% (577) since the last census in 2001.
- The Gujarati speaking community has increased since the ABS Census of 2001 by 225% (419) to 605 people. Other Indian languages have also increased including the Marathi speaking community that has increased by 152% (50) to 83 people, Malayalam community by 110% (33) to 63 people, the Hindi speaking community has increased by 67% (362) to 905 people and the Punjabi speaking population has increased by 61% (123) to 222 people. The Korean speaking community has also increased by 39% (130) to 461 people.
- A number of the smaller communities have a large percentage of the population aged 18 years or less, 59% (10) of the Dinka, 48% (10) of the Sindhi, 47% (9) of the Lao, 33% (6) of the Albanian and 32% (6) of the Shona⁵ speaking communities are in this age cohort. In the larger communities a smaller percentage of the community is aged 18 years or less. Nineteen percent (925) of the Greek speaking community, 13% (119) of the Hindi, 10% (336) of the Italian, 24% (1282) of the Mandarin speaking community and 21% (996) of the Cantonese speaking community are aged 18 years or less.
- Fifteen percent (17152) of people who speak English at home are aged between 19 and 29 years, for people who speak a language other than English at home 20% (6260) of the population is in this age group. In the smaller communities a significant percentage of their population is in this age group. One hundred percent (10) of the French Creole, 77% (10) of the Swahili, 41% (7) of the Dinka speaking community, 52% (17) of the Kannada and 60% (50) of the Marathi are in this age group. Seventy five percent (453) of the Gujarati speaking community is aged between 19 and 29 years, 52% (472) of the Hindi, 46% (296) of the Indonesian, 27% (3286) of the Mandarin, and 19% of the Cantonese (2104) and the Vietnamese (358) speaking communities are in this age cohort.
- Twenty seven percent (31580) of Boroondara's population who speak English at home and 32% (9868) of the population who speaks a language other than English at home are aged between 30 and 49 years. Twenty nine percent (274391) of the region's total population is aged between 30 and 49 years. In the Afrikaans speaking community 57% (44) of the community is in this age group, 40% (10) of the Bosnian, 46% (11) of the Bulgarian, 66% (21) of the Burmese, 80% (33) of the Malayalam and 50% (25) of the Danish speaking communities are aged between 30 and 49 years. In larger communities 32% (1058) of the Italian, 30% (1423) of the Cantonese, 32% (1678) of the Mandarin, 36% (1791) of the Greek and 32% (360) of the Vietnamese speaking communities are in this age group.

- Ten percent (97784) of the total regional population is aged 70 years or over. In the City of Boroondara 11% (12516) of the population who speak English at home and 10% (3197) of the population who speaks a language other than English at home are aged 70 years or more. Nineteen percent (3197) of all people aged 70 years or more in the City of Boroondara speak a language other than English at home. In the older well established communities a significant percentage of the population speak a language other than English at home. In the Armenian speaking community 35% (11), in the Belorussian 50% (6), Croatian 27% (65), Estonian, 63% (10) and 39% of the Hungarian (103) and Lithuanian (23) speaking communities are aged 70 years or more. In the larger communities 3% (152) of the Mandarin speaking communities, 16% (779) of the Greek, 6% (284) of the Cantonese, 27% (906) Italian, 3% (30) Vietnamese and 1% (5) Hindi speaking communities are 70 years or more.

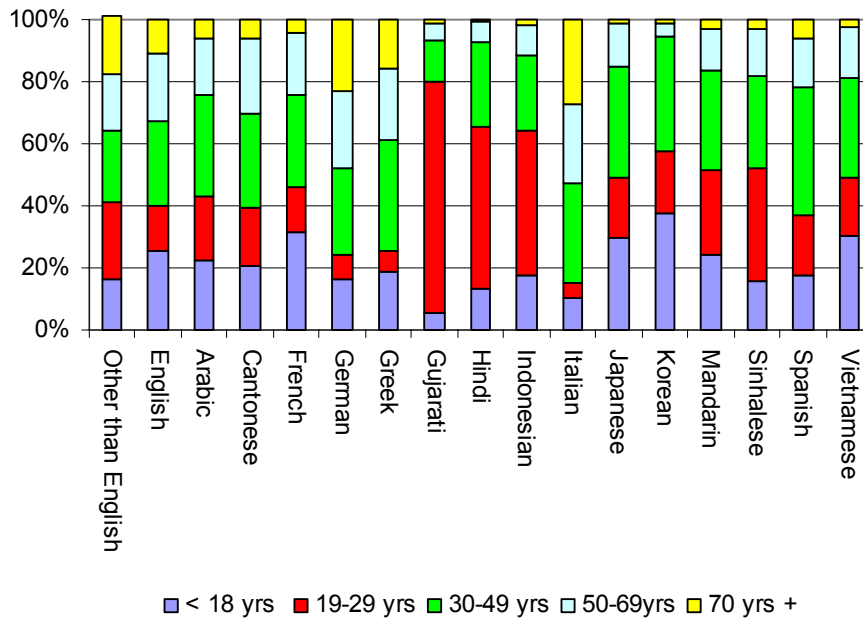

The largest percentage, 25% (318) of the English speaking community is aged 18 years or less. Within communities who speak a language other than English at home (19%) 5952 of people are in this age group. People who speak Mandarin (5257) are the largest language group speaking a language other than English at home. The second largest population speaking a language other than English at home speak Greek (5257), and 36% (1791) of this community is aged between 30 and 49 years.

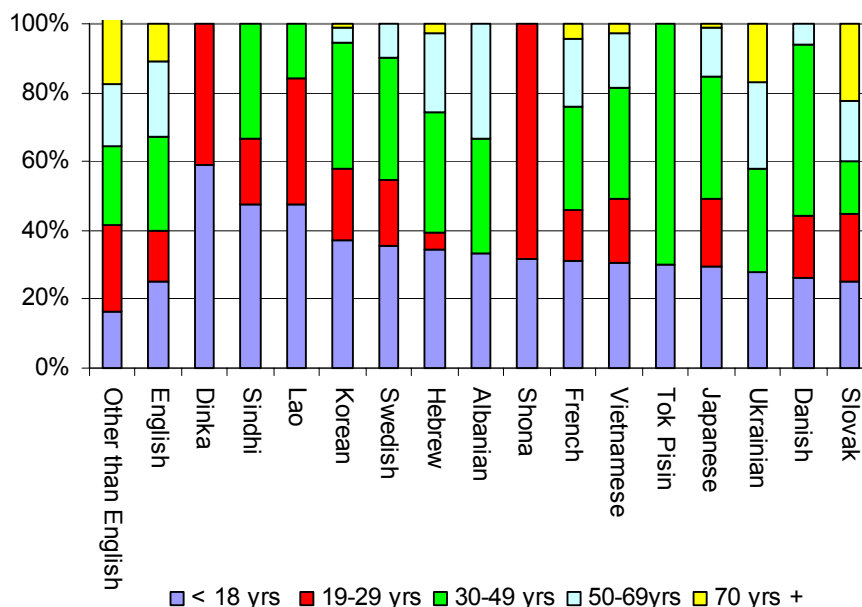
Twenty seven percent (1436) of the Mandarin speaking community, 7% (324) of the Greek, 19% (892) of the Cantonese, 5% (173) of the Italian, 19% (206) of the Vietnamese and 52% (472) of the Hindi speaking communities are aged between 19 and 29 years. Across the region as a whole 15% (140963) of the population is in this age cohort.

Thirty two percent (1678) of the Mandarin speaking community are aged between 30 and 49 years. Twenty nine percent (274391) of the total regional population is in this age group. Thirty six percent (1791) of the Greek, 30% (1423) of the Cantonese, 32% (1058) of the Italian and 32% (360) of the Vietnamese speaking communities are in this age cohort.

Thirteen percent (709) of the Mandarin speaking community are aged between 50 and 69 years. Across the region 22% (213054) of the total population is in this age cohort. Twenty five percent (1174) of the Cantonese speaking community, 26% (851) of the Italian, 16% (176) of the Vietnamese and 7% (63) of the Hindi speaking communities are in this age group.

Ten percent (97784) of the total regional population is aged 70 years or over. Three percent (152) of the Mandarin speaking community is in this age group, 16% (779) of the Greek, 6% (284) of the Cantonese, 27% (906) of the Italian, 3% (30) of the Vietnamese, 1% (5) of the Hindi, 23% (161) of the German, 2% (10) of the Indonesian and 1% (9) of the Gujarati speaking communities are in this age group.

Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged 18 years or less in the City of Boroondara

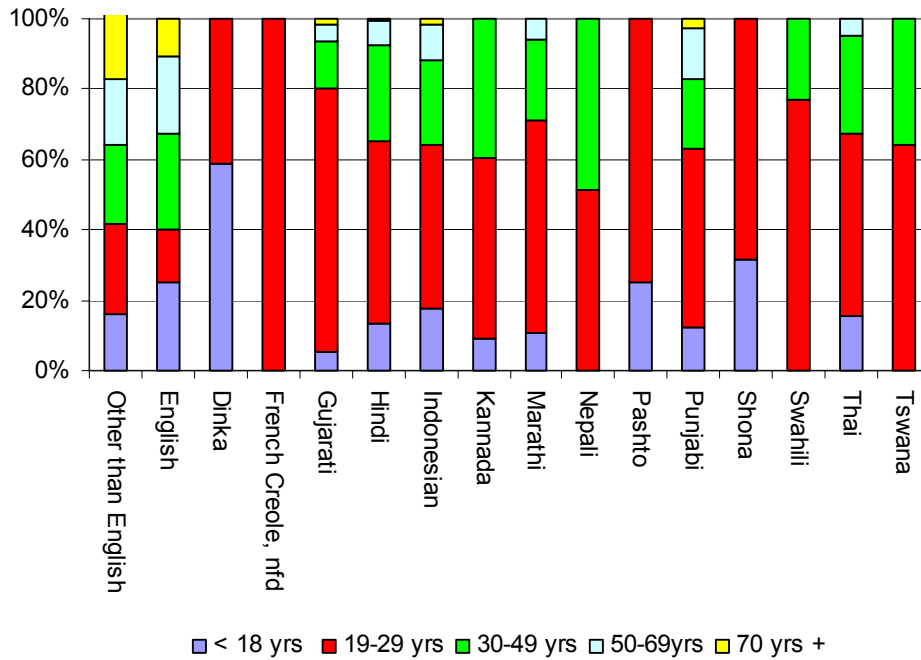


In the City of Boroondara 25% (29148) of the people who speak English at home are aged 18 years or less. For people who speak a language other than English at home 19% (5952) of the population in this age cohort. Across the region 24% (230614) of the population is aged 18 years or less.

A number of the smaller communities have a large percentage of the population in this age cohort, 59% (10) of the Dinka, 48% (10) of the Sindhi, 47% (9) of the Lao, 33% (6) of the Albanian and 32% (6) of the Shona⁷ speaking communities are in this age cohort. Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged between 19 and 29 years in the City of Boroondara



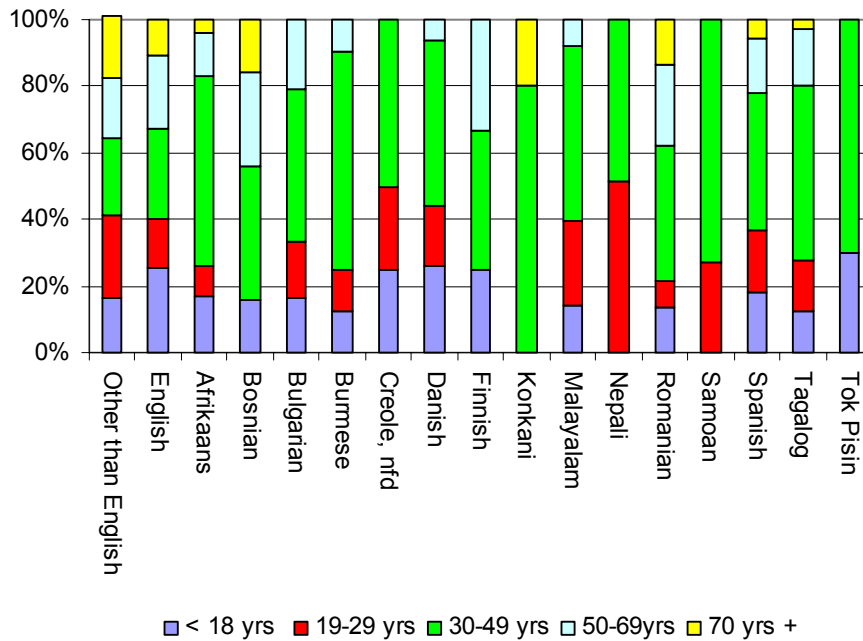

Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged between 30 and 49 years in the City of Boroondara

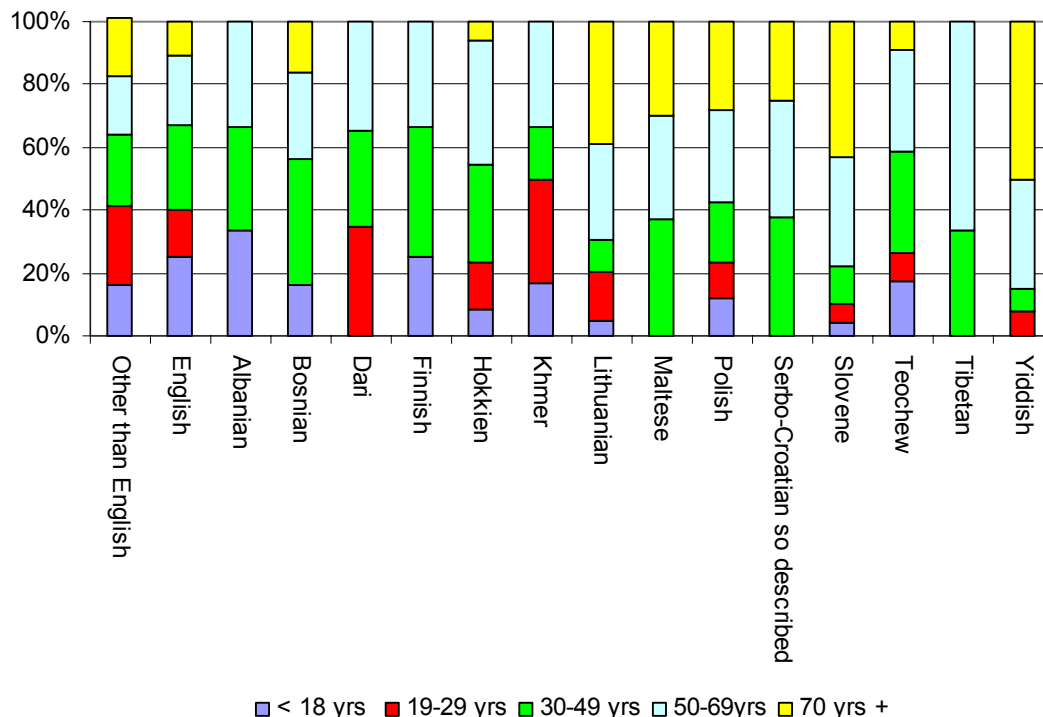

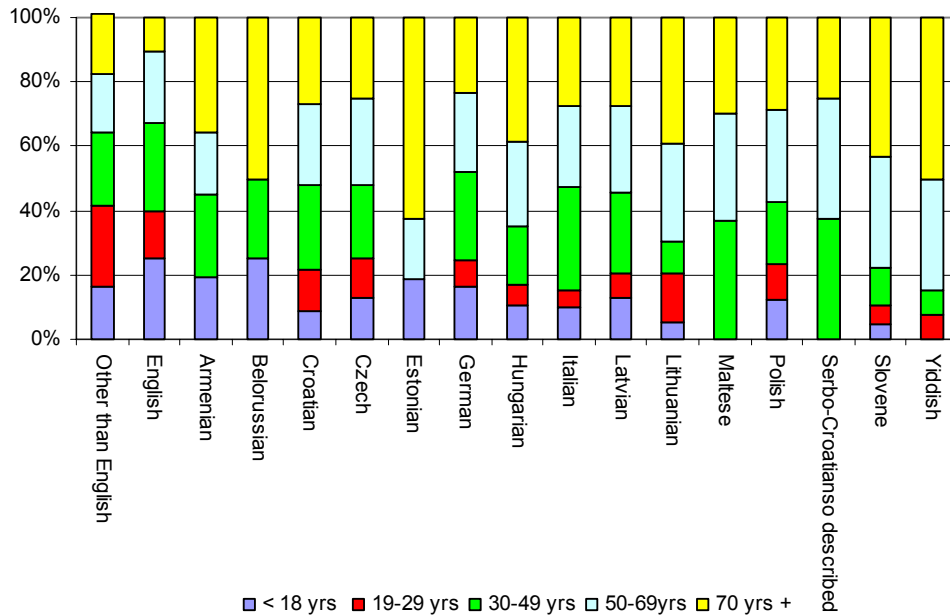
Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged between 50 and 69 years in the City of Boroondara



Twenty two percent (25414) of the community who speaks English at home are aged 50 to 69 years and in the population who speaks a language other than English at home 19% (6004) are in this age cohort. Across the region 22% (213054) of the total population is in this age cohort.

In the larger communities, 23% (1142) of the Greek, 25% (1174) of the Cantonese and 26% (851) of the Italian speaking communities are in this age group. In smaller communities 33% of the Albanian (6), Khmer (6) and the Finnish (22) speaking communities are in this age cohort and 28% (7) of the Bosnian, 40% (117) of the Hokkien and 31% (18) of the Lithuanian speaking communities are aged between 50 and 69 years.

In the City of Boroondara 11% (12516) of the population who speak English at home and 10% (3197) of the population who speaks a language other than English at home are aged 70 years or more. Nineteen percent (3197) of all people aged 70 years or more in the City of Boroondara speak a language other than English at home.

In the older well established communities a significant percentage of the population speak a language other than English at home. In the Armenian speaking community 35% (11), in the Belorussian 50% (6), in the Croatian 27% (65), in the Estonian 63% (10) and 39% of the Hungarian (103) and Lithuanian (23) speaking communities are aged 70 years or more.

In the larger communities 3% (152) of the Mandarin speaking communities, 16% (779) of the Greek, 6% (284) of the Cantonese, 27% (906) Italian, 3% (30) Vietnamese and 1% (5) Hindi speaking communities are aged 70 years or more.
