

## **Settlement in Yarra Ranges of Melbourne 2005/2006**

### **Country of Birth:**

There were 116 people who settled in Yarra Ranges in 2005/06 from overseas. This represents a 1% decrease from 2004/05. The largest number of people were born in United Kingdom (42) followed by Philippines (20) and Myanmar (19).

Across the Eastern Region in 2005/06 there was an 11% decrease in new settlement compared to 2004/05 whilst across Victoria there was a 4% increase in 2005/06 compared to 2004/05.

### **Migration Stream**

There were 54 people (46% of the total) who settled under the skilled migration program, 39 people (34% of the total) under the family migration program and 23 people (20% of the total) under the humanitarian program.

Under the skilled migration program the largest number were born in United Kingdom (35), for the family program the largest number was born in Philippines (20) and for the humanitarian program the largest number were born in Myanmar (19).

Across the Eastern Region 1633 (61% of the total) settled under the skilled migration program, 947 (36% of the total) under the family migration program and 82 (3% of the total) under the humanitarian program.

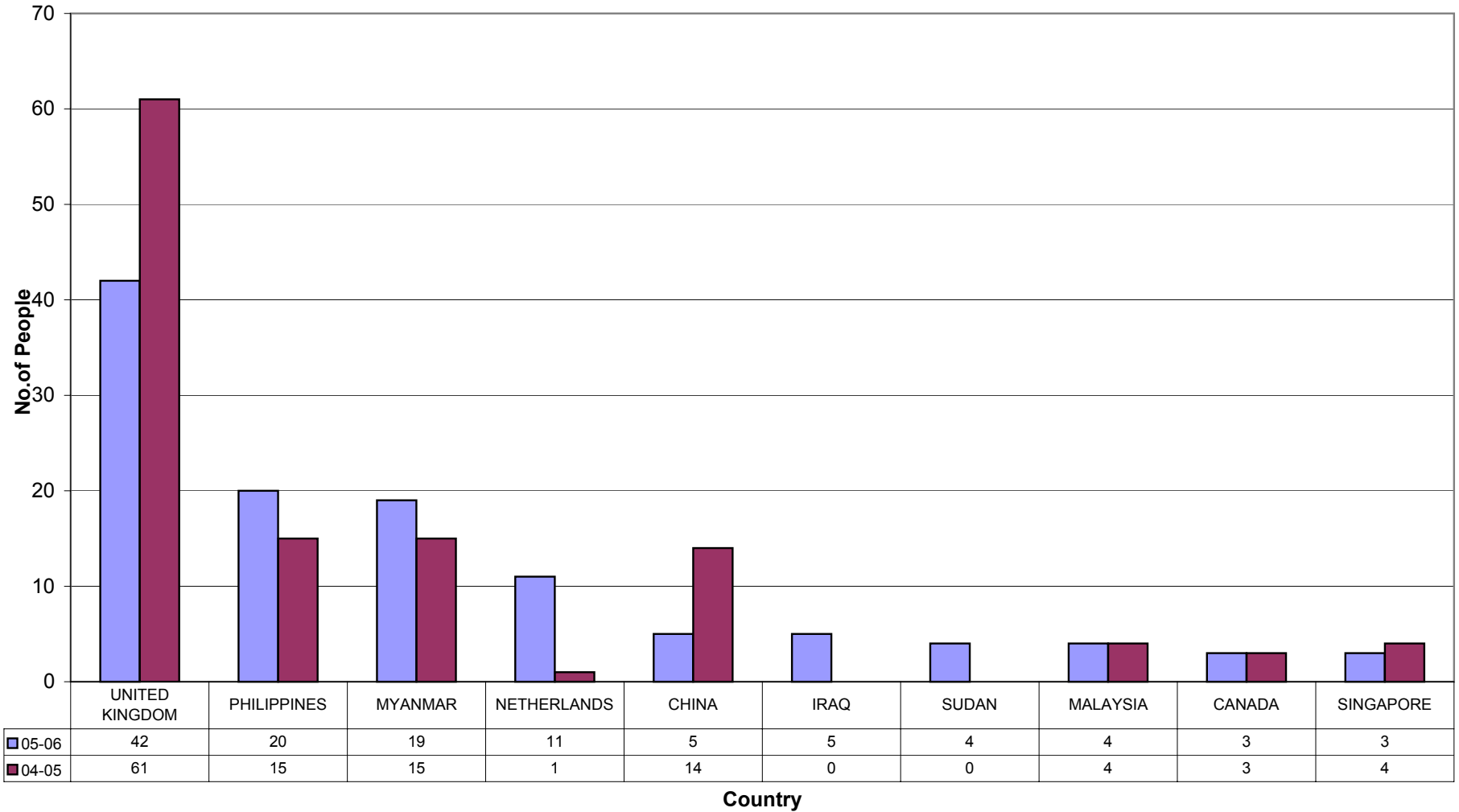
### **Children:**

There were 43 children who settled in Yarra Ranges from overseas in 2005/06, this represents a 34% increase from 2004/05.

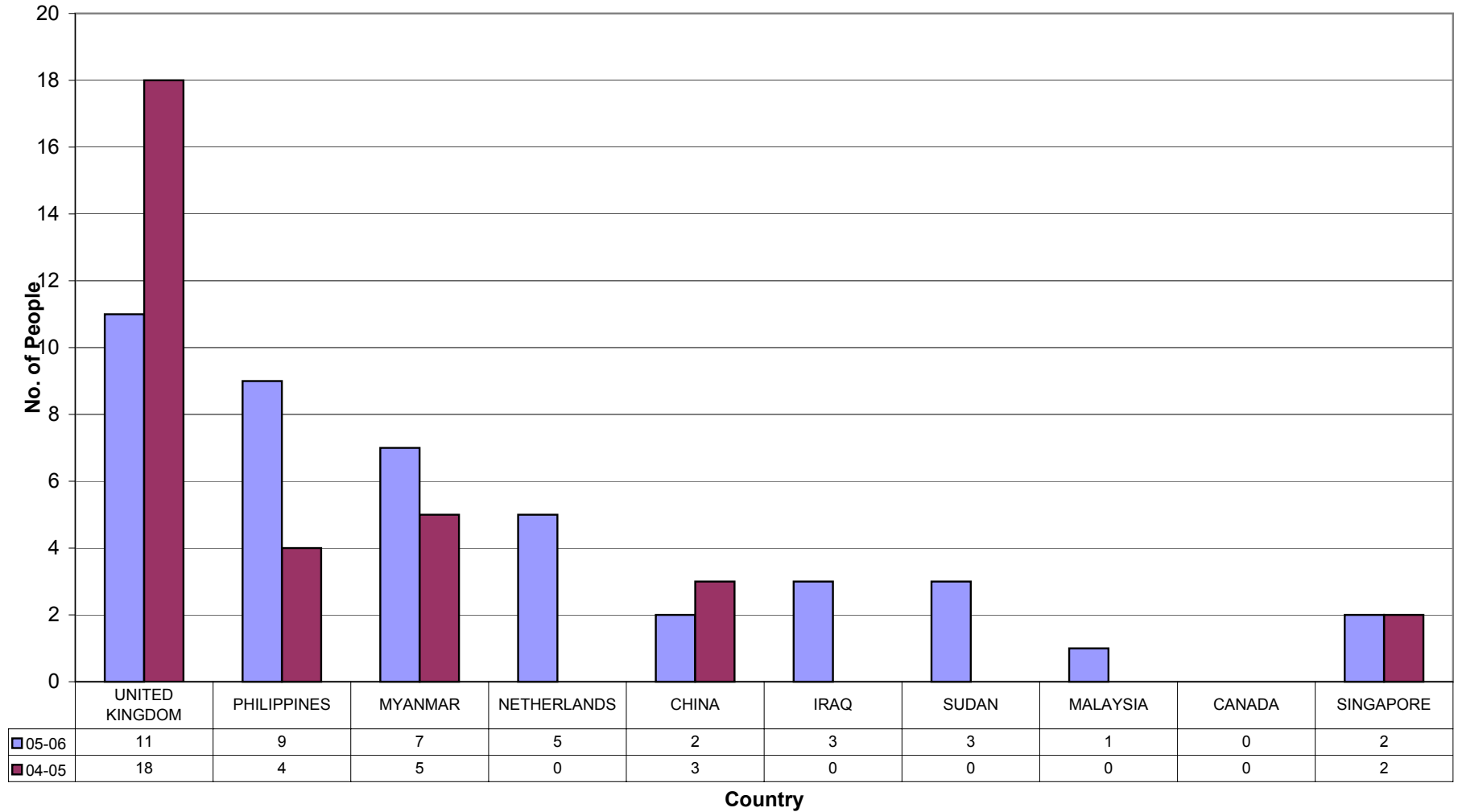
The largest number of children were born in United Kingdom (11) followed by Philippines (9) and Myanmar (7).

Across the Eastern Region, 648 children settled from overseas in 2005/06, this represents a 14% decrease from 2004/05.

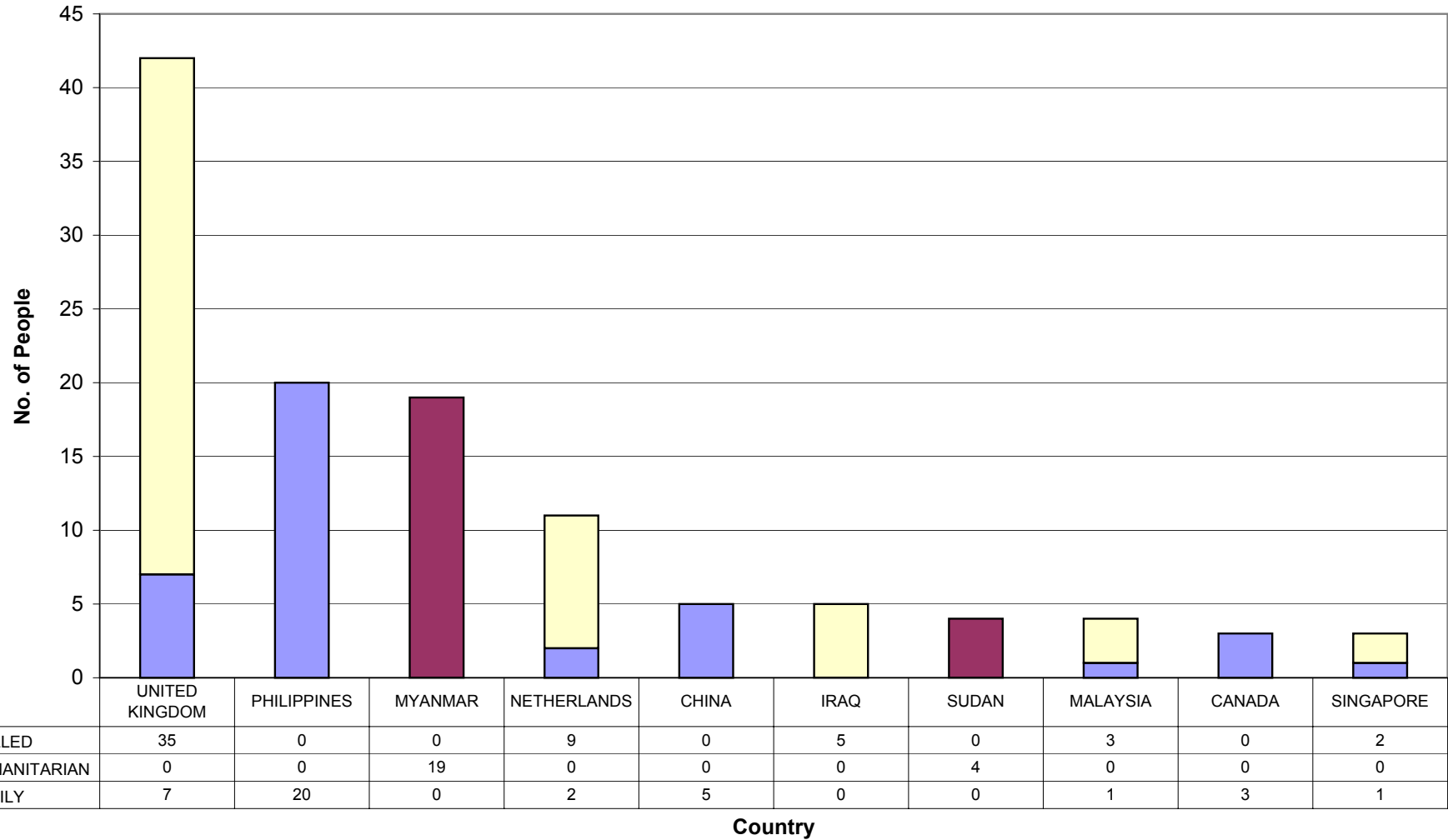
**2005/06 and 2004/05 Country of Birth(Yarra Ranges)**
