

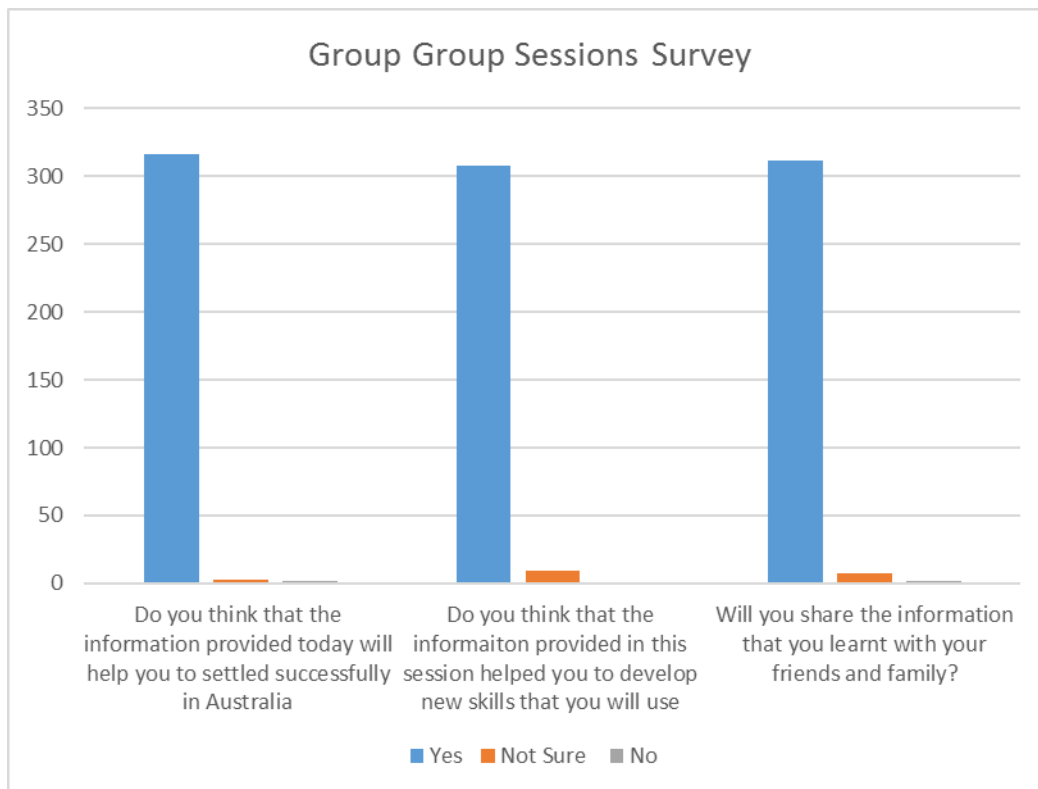
Settlement Grants Program Information Sessions January to June 2016
