

The Migrant Information Centre (Eastern Melbourne) provided settlement support for 810 clients across 2,619 sessions during the period of January 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup> 2018. Client came from 24 different countries of birth with the graph below displaying the top 10 countries. Within the reporting period 69% of clients came from Burma with clients from Iran making up the second largest group of 14%. Those in the 'other' category had less than 10 people arriving from Somalia, Indonesia, Afghanistan, Liberia, Tibet, Greece, Chad, Vietnam, South Sudan, Malaysia, UK and Venezuela.
